Now I understand the economy is bad and that everything looks bleak, but if our health insurance is ~~that~~ taken away from us it would put us in grave danger.

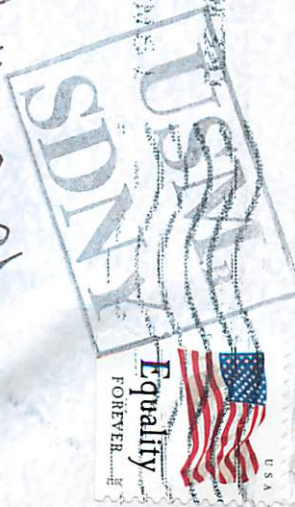
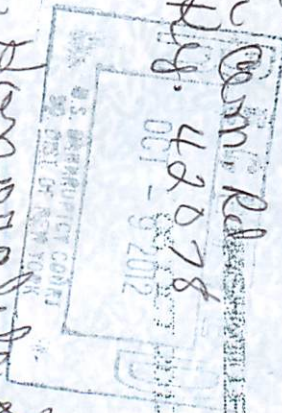
Since 1998 until now I have had 2 heart attacks a stroke 3 operations, I can't afford to be without health insurance, My Medication
