**RESPONSE AND OBJECTION OF KANAWHA RIVER TERMINALS, LLC TO
EIGHTH OMNIBUS NOTICE OF REJECTION OF
CERTAIN EXECUTORY CONTRACTS DATED DECEMBER 18, 2012**

Now comes Kanawha River Terminals, LLC, (“KRT”) by and through its undersigned counsel, objects to the Notice of Rejection of Certain Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases on Schedules “A” [Docket # 1771, page 4] (the “Rejection Notice”) and in support thereof states as follows:

1. KRT is a party to that certain Transloading and Blending Agreement dated December 29, 2010 with Patriot Coal Sales, LLC (the “Agreement”).
2. The rejection by the Debtor of the Agreement is improvident in that the loss of the use of coal loading and blending facility and services provided by KRT pursuant to the Agreement will negatively impact the Debtor’s coal sales operations and increase the cost of its coal sales. In addition, the rejection of the Agreement will result in of significant rejection claims against the Debtor that will negatively impact the estate of the Debtor and the recovery to be achieved by the general unsecured creditors.
3. KRT expressly reserves all of its rights to assert additional objections to the Rejection Notice on any and all grounds

WHEREFORE, KRT respectfully requests that the Court deny the Rejection Notice and grant it such other and further relief as is proper and just.
