\$650 per month plus health benefits.

In 1999, I had aorta replacement surgery
at Cleveland Clinic. I have had gall bladder
removed. I am also being treated for high
blood pressure and depression. My family's
financial situation would definitely be
affected negatively if my insurance was
taken away. Working for lower wages
all those years made it hard to plan
for no insurance coverage and no pension.
We trusted as agreed upon that those
issues would be taken care of.

I urge you to insure that Patriot
Coal can not go back on their promises.

to those of us who have dedicated
our working lives for the benefit
of the coal companies.

Being retired since 1999, I must
have this health care insurance and
small retirement to enjoy any quality
of life without undo financial
and health consequences

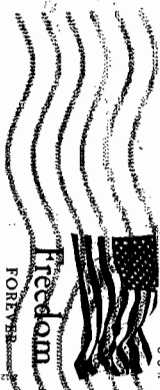
