to consider the men, women, and





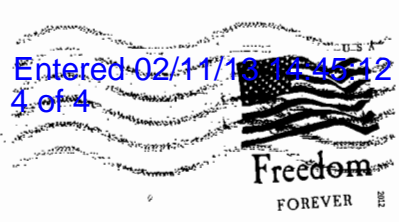
Children whose lives will be affected
