I spent 21^{1/4} years working in the coal mines for Peabody Coal Co., in which I was always told by Peabody coal people that I would have my Health care and pension for life after 20 years of service. I worked day and nite all those years mainly for these benefits.

I worked under ground in very dangerous conditions. I lost three good in the coal mines. I have severe asthma in which my monthly medicine would cost me about 500.⁰⁰ alone. my pension is only \$452.⁰⁰ a month. My wife has had one bout of cancer. I am looking at having 2 knee replacements in the next year or two. I do not think me and my wife could make it with out benefits. I worked with the promise of having them for life and I will really need them.

A long with my asthma the coal dust
has not been good on my lungs either,
my dad died with black lung only
3 months after retiring from Peabody Coal.

It is also add I have never worked
one day out of my 21 years in the mines
for Patriot Coal Co., all my time was
with Peabody Coal Co.

I ask your help and Gods in helping
us miners keep our promised medical
and pensions.

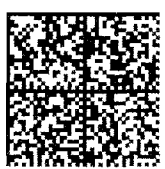
