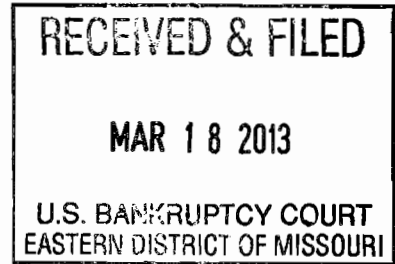



I appreciate any help you can give us in this manner.*

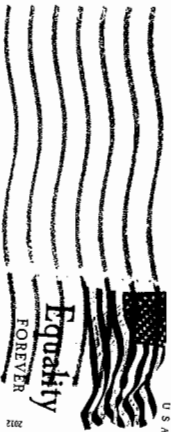
