ON JANUARY 27 2014 I RECEIVED BY CERTIFIED MAIL A LETTER FROM PATRIOT COAL CORPORATION VICE PRESIDENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES & EMPLOYEE SERVICES MICHAEL J. LUNA INFORMING ME THE PROOF OF CLAIM AND CORRESPONDENCE I FILED WITH THE BANKRUPTCY COURT HAD BEEN FORWARDED TO HIM A COPY OF LETTER IS ENCLOSED. HOWEVER I OBJECT TO HIS POSITION THAT THE PROPOSED DISALLOWANCE OF MY CLAIM WILL NOT

"ADVERSELY AFFECT ME IN ANY WAY" THIS IS NOT TRUE AS IT HAS AFFECTED ME ALMOST IN EVERY WAY. ENCLOSED YOU WILL FIND JUST A SMALL AMOUNT OF THE PAPER WORK I RECEIVE ON A DAILY BASIS.

STARTING FROM DENIALS OF UNITED HEALTH CARE TO PAY FOR SOME MEDICATIONS THAT ARE PRESCRIBED BY THE DOCTOR'S THAT I SEE FOR MY DIABETIS - HEART-CONDITION AND PAIN MANAGEMENT ETC.

FOR AN EXAMPLE FOR MY DIABETIS CONTROL ONE OF THE MEDICINES I HAVE TAKEN FOR PAST 10 YEARS CALLED METFORMIN ER 750 mg TAKE 2 TABLETS 2 TIMES PER DAY. I RECEIVED A NOTICE IN MAIL THAT UNITED HEALTH CARE - PATRIOT COAL PAYER ID NO 87726 FOR PART B DRUGS WOULD NOT PAY FOR METFORMIN 750 mg 2 TABLETS TAKEN 2 TIMES PER DAY BUT WOULD ONLY PAY FOR 1 TABLET TAKEN 2 TIMES PER DAY SO I SHOWED THE NOTICE TO MY DOCTOR I HAVE HAD FOR PAST 11 YEARS FOR CONTROL OF MY DIABETIS HIS REPLY WAS WOW I DIDN'T KNOW THE INSURANCE COMPANY WAS IN THE BUSINESS OF PRESCRIBING MEDICATION SO NOW I TAKE 1 TABLET OF METFORMIN

TWICE A DAY BECAUSE THIS IS ALL UNITED HEALTH CARE WILL PAY FOR FOR CONTROL OF MY DIABETIS SO NOW MY RIGHT FOOT PAINS ME BECAUSE I AM TAKING LESS MEDICATION AND "O-YES" I DID CALL THE HUMAN RESOURCES BENEFITS HOTLINE AS RECOMMENDED BY MR. MICHAEL J. LUNA VICE-PRESIDENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES & EMPLOYEE SERVICES HOTLINE NO (800) 633-9005 MANY-MANY TIMES ALMOST ON A WEEKLY BASIS AND MOST OF TIME WITH NO RESULTS OR WE WILL LOOK INTO IT AND GET BACK TO YOU. "LIKE THIS WILL HAPPEN".

I HAVE PROBLEMS WITH HOSPITAL & DOCTOR BILLS TO THE EXTENT IT IS JUST UN-BELIEVABLE BILLS FROM A FEW DOLLARS TO \$12,000.00 SEE ENCLOSED BILL. THIS IS NEVER ENDING AND GETTING WORSE THAN IS JUST ONE EXAMPLE. THIS IS HOW I CAME TO ASKING FOR A SETTLEMENT WHEN I GOT A NOTICE IN MAIL THAT PATRIOT COAL CO. WHO USE TO BE ARCH OF ILLINOIS WHO I WAS WORKING FOR WHEN I HAD MY

ACCIDENT WHILE WORKING FOR ARCH OF ILLINOIS IN SEPTEMBER 1987 AND HAVE NEVER WORKED SINCE ON THAT DAY MY WORLD AS I NEW IT ENDED BEFORE ACCIDENT I WORKED 7 DAYS PER WEEK ABOUT 8 OR 12 HOURS PER DAY SOME TIMES MORE THE MONEY WAS EXCELENT AND I LOVED MY JOB AS A (SHOOTER) - CLASSIFICATION ON DRILLS FOR BLAITING OVERBURDEN IN STRIP-MINING OPERATION LIFE WAS GOOD AND THEN IT ALL ENDED ON SEPT-1987 MY 2 BOYS WERE 13-15 YEARS AND VERY MUCH IN NEEDS OF A FATHER AND ABOUT 2 YRS MY ~~LEFT ME~~ WIFE LEFT ME THIS STILL TO THIS HANTS ME TO THIS VERY DAY.

THE U.M.W.A. IS LIMITED IN TIME AS TO HOW LONG IT WILL BE FUNCTIONAL AS A WORKING UNION REFER TO LETTER TO ME DATED FEBRUARY 3 2014 AS I HAVE NOT PAID MEMBERSHIP DUES FOR THE LAST 23 YEARS AND U.M.W.A IS VERY MUCH AWARE OF THIS TO MYSELF THIS MEANS NO \$316.62 PER MONTH ALSO IN A MATTER OF TIME WHAT WILL COME OF PATRIOT COAL CO.?

YOUR HONOR THESE ARE SOME OF THE REASONS WHY I AM ASKING FOR THE AMOUNT OF 750,000.00 SO I CAN TAKE CARE OF MY HEALTH OR NURSING HOME ALSO MY PRESCRIPTION DRUG COST WILL ONLY INCREASE AS TIME GOES ON AND I PLAN TO LIVE FOR A LONG TIME AND I DO NOT WANT TO BE A BURDEN TO MY SON JERFT WYCISKALL AS HE HAS A WIFE AND FOUR YOUNG CHILDREN HE HAS JUST ON JANUARY 27 TURNED 40 YRS OLD WHEN I WAS DIVORCED FROM MY WIFE IN 1992 HE IS THE ONE WHO LOOKED OUT FOR MY WELL BEING BUT HIS RESPONSABILITY WITH 4 CHILDREN THEIR IS LIMITED TIME HE CAN HELP ME AS I LIVE IN A OLD MOBIL HOME THAT HAS WOOD HEAT THIS WINTER WITH ALL THE SNOW AND SEVERE COLD I CAN'T LIVE HERE ANOTHER WINTER WITH MOVING INTO ASSISTED LIVING OR A (HOME NURSING) AND I KNOW ABOUT CONDITIONS IN SOME HOMES, I WOULD LIKE TO HAVE MONEY TO PAY FOR A DECIENT PLACE TO LIVE.

I DIDN'T MEAN TO COMPLAIN ABOUT MY PROBLEMS AS EVERYONE HAS THEM BUT I JUST WANT TO TAKE CARE OF MYSELF AND TO DO THAT I NEED INCOME WHICH I DON'T HAVE TO MAINTAIN A REASONABLE LIFESTYLE BECAUSE I BELIEVE I PAID MY DUES SO TO SPEAK BECAUSE WHEN I WORKED IN STRIP MINE I GAVE IT MY ALL AND DID NOT MIND WORKING 7 DAYS PER WEEK AND LONG HOURS ALSO SINCE I WAS 18 YEARS OLD UNTIL I PAID DUES INTO THE OPERATING ENGINEERS LOCAL 520 ENGINEERS ROAD GRANITE CITY ILLINOIS 62040 RECEIVED 30 YEAR PIN ENCLOSED AS I ALWAYS THOUGHT I WOULD GET BETTER SO I COULD RETURN TO WORK SO I DIDN'T HAVE TO DEPEND ON ANYONE PLEASE TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION ALL OF THIS WHEN YOU MAKE YOUR DECISION.

Dear Mr. Wyciskalla:

I am the Vice President of Human Resources and Employee Services for Patriot Coal. The proof of claim and correspondence you filed with the Bankruptcy Court have been forwarded to me.

You receive healthcare benefits from Patriot under the Coal Industry Retiree Health Benefit Act of 1992, which we usually refer to as the "Coal Act." The obligations of Patriot and the benefits of retirees under the Coal Act were not affected by Patriot's recent Chapter 11 case. You remain a participant in Patriot's Coal Act benefit plan, and your benefits have not been reduced. To this point, your healthcare benefits have remained unchanged during the bankruptcy process. If you are experiencing any problems with the administration of your healthcare benefits, please contact our Human Resources Benefits Hotline at (800) 633-9005.

We requested that our attorneys object to the \$750,000 claim you filed because you have not suffered any loss as a result of the bankruptcy case, and so it would not be appropriate for you to receive a payment in addition to the continuation of your benefits. The hearing on the objection to your claim will be rescheduled, at your request, to February 25, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. You should feel free to seek independent legal advice and to participate in the hearing if you wish, but it is Patriot's position that the proposed disallowance of your claim will not adversely affect you in any way.
