Your Honor:

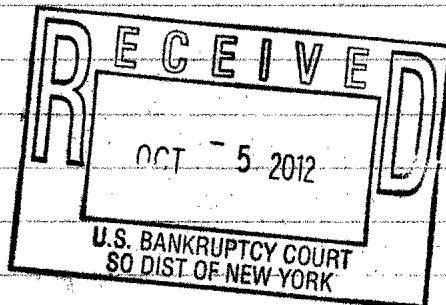
I am writing this letter in hopes that you will consider our plight. Your decision on the Patriot Coal Bankruptcy could affect our life greatly.

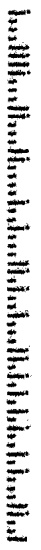

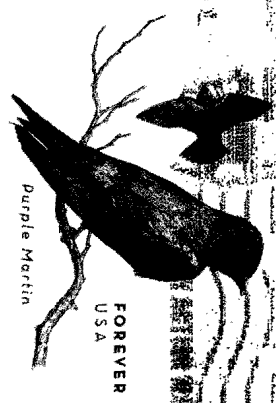
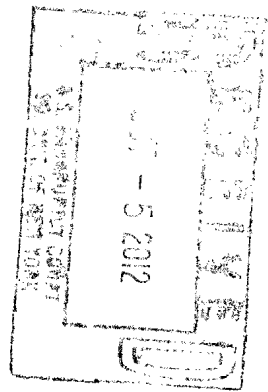
